TC2 prerequisites:

- Completion of TC1 RISS00058 Traffic Controller Skill Set for Urban Streets and Low Volume Rural Roads
- At least 40 hours of experience as a traffic controller after completion of TC1

TMI2 prerequisites are:

- Completion of the TMI1 RISS00060 Traffic Management Implementer Skill Set for Urban Streets and Low Volume Rural Roads (TMI Essentials); and
- At least one month experience applying skills and knowledge relevant to the above-mentioned skill set in a temporary traffic management workplace;
- and/or
- Providing evidence of relevant experience setting up at least 12 temporary traffic management types which may include high speed roads or high-volume roads, and at least two of the following types:
 - pedestrian and cyclist controls
 - construction sites
 - lane closures
 - shoulder closures
 - night works
 - use of portable traffic control devices
 - motorways or freeways

12 x Traffic Worksheets / Timesheets or payslips which cover a (1) one month period, and which include a minimum of 40 hours and at least 12 different live set ups (Locations)
